[A] Agnes met Tony at a community picnic. He was tall and handsome, and he had a good job. He worked as a pipe fitter at the paper mill in town. On the side, Tony fixed the broken taps and plugged drain pipes of people's homes. He made good money because the people in town knew that Tony was a good honest worker. To Agnes, Tony looked like the kind of man a woman could marry and live with happily.

[B] Agnes had been only fifteen when she came from the farm in Lena to help her older sister Anna. Anna's husband, my grandfather, had a grocery business in town. They had many people working for them in the store. Anna had to help in the store, to keep the workers on the job. So Agnes came to help with the children. After a year, another cousin came from Iron River to help at the house. That's when Agnes got a job at the bakery in town. She learned how to make bread and all kinds of fancy cakes and cookies. Everyone loved Agnes, especially Tony. Agnes was easy to love because she was so pretty and so much fun. She was also a very good cook. Agnes was the kind of woman a man could marry and live with happily.

[C] About a year later, Tony asked Agnes to marry him. Tony bought a house on the main street of town and fixed it up. He painted it and put in nice carpeting. The house had two stories. There was a kitchen, dining room, living room, and front porch on the first floor. Upstairs, there were three large bedrooms, a bathroom, and an area at the top of the house to store things. In the basement, there was a place for the car, a workshop for Tony's plumbing tools, and a neat laundry room with a washing machine, a long table, and two big lead sinks. It was a comfortable house. When Tony

and Agnes got married, they moved in. Nothing could destroy their happiness.

[D] The big problem occurred a week after their marriage, on a Monday morning. Agnes lost her wedding ring. Tony had saved all his extra money for nearly a year to buy Agnes the gold band with seven little diamonds in it. And Agnes lost it. She remembered (27) it in the morning as she was taking the dirty clothes downstairs to the basement to wash them in her new washing machine. However, at noon, she no longer had the ring on her finger.

[E] Agnes was beyond comfort, and at first she couldn't even tell Tony. She told her sister, and Agnes and Anna searched the house from (29) to bottom, but the ring was nowhere to be found. When Agnes told Tony, he took the pipes in the laundry room apart, in case the ring had fallen into one of the drains. However, the ring was gone. Agnes found a simple silver band to wear in place of the precious wedding ring Tony had given her on their wedding day. Every day she saw that silver band. Every day she thought about her lost wedding ring.

[F] The years passed, and their children were born. First came three daughters. Joan was their first, and then Delores was born. A few years later Maureen was born, and then they had a son, Roger. Their marriage was a happy one, but Agnes never stopped looking for her wedding ring.

[G] The children grew up and went to college, and Agnes and Tony were happy and proud of their family. On their thirtieth wedding anniversary, Tony surprised Agnes with a special gift. It was a gold wedding ring with seven little diamonds. It was just like the one he had given her on their wedding day thirty years before. Agnes thought for a moment that Tony had found the lost ring, but then she realized that he had bought her a new one. She was very happy, because a beautiful wedding ring meant a lot to her.

[H] A few days later, on Monday morning, Agnes picked up the basket of dirty clothes to go downstairs to her laundry room. She had a new automatic washing machine now. However, she still liked to wash some things by hand in the big lead sinks. She put the black rubber plug into one sink and turned on the tap. She was feeling the temperature of the water as she prepared to wash a white sweater by hand. She saw how the diamonds of the new wedding ring sparkled in the water. She gently took the ring off her finger. She wasn't going to lose this ring! She looked up at the pieces of wood that supported the roof above her washing machine. She wanted to find a nail on which to put her new ring. And there she saw a nail. But there was something on it! There hung her first wedding ring, which she had put there to be safe, thirty years before.
